

SNOW PROCEDURES FOR GOLD RUSH *COUNTRY* SCHOOL (1/24/11)

1. If you have a radio, tune to KKBN 93.5 FM or KVML 1450 A.M. and listen to find out if *Gold Rush Country School at Sullivan Creek* has a delayed opening or is closed. (Gold Rush has more than one campus, including one at Summerville High School on Tuolumne Rd. so make sure which campus you are listening for.)
2. If you do not have a radio, go to MyMotherLode.com on the Internet and click on *community*, then *schools* to find out if we are delayed or closed.
3. If you have neither a radio or a computer and you have a phone, you can call The Country School coordinator Cheryl Divine at home 536-1689 (or cell 510-449-1669) between 6:30-7:30 a.m. or Shannon Owens at 985-4399 (cell) to find out if we are closed or delayed.
4. If you have a phone, all parents should receive an automated message from Gold Rush stating closures, etc.
5. **NEVER, EVER** drive to the school on a possible snow day and just drop your child off. You must make eye contact with a teacher or see one of our cars; otherwise your child could be stranded!!
6. Your child should continue to do school work on snow days. The students have either been given snow packets ahead of time, or you may access their assignments on line. This allows us to claim their attendance and get funding. Thank you.
